CALIFORNIA HEALTHY WORKPLACES/HEALTHY FAMILIES ACT OF 2014 PAID SICK LEAVE

Entitlement:

- California law provides that an employee who, on or after July 1, 2015, works in California
 for 30 or more days within a year from the beginning of employment is entitled to paid
 sick leave that, as a minimum, accrues up to 3 days or 24 hours of accrued paid sick
 leave per year.
- Autodesk provides paid Sick Leave at the employee's regular wage rate in accordance with Company policy beginning on the first day of employment.
- Autodesk policy does not strictly limit the use of Sick Leave. Employees may be eligible
 for short-term disability after seven consecutive calendar days of paid Sick Leave. Sick
 Leave does not accrue or carryover from year-to-year.

Usage:

- An eligible employee may use accrued paid sick days beginning on the first day of employment.
- Eligible employees may use paid sick days upon oral or written request for themselves or a
 family member for the diagnosis, care or treatment of an existing health condition or
 preventive care, or specified purposes for an employee who is a victim of domestic
 violence, sexual assault, or stalking.
- Although Autodesk does not strictly limit use of Sick Leave, employees are expected to
 use Sick Leave responsibly. A general guideline for excessive use of Sick Leave is
 anything more than ten days within a 12-month period of time.

Retaliation or discrimination against an employee who requests paid sick days or uses paid sick days or both is prohibited. An employee can file a complaint with the Labor Commissioner against an employer who retaliates or discriminates against the employee.
